

## Cooper House Sliding Scale

We believe that optimal development for children is only possible in a just and equitable community. We are committed to making professional development and Reflective Consultation opportunities accessible to prenatal-five workers in our region.

Every professional and organization's budget and access to resources is different and influenced by systems of oppression. Our Sliding Scale seeks to promote equity by partnering with state-wide agencies that sponsor some organizations, and by discounting the training cost for other organizations.

## Funding Sources

### Washington

WA's Home Visiting Services Account (HVSA) sponsors home visitors and supervisors from supported agencies in Washington. Check [this list](#) to see if your agency's home-visiting program is part of the HVSA portfolio. If so, contact [Nina Evers](#) for more information.

### Oregon

## Sliding Scale Fees

**Option A:** 100% standard rate | This rate covers the cost for us to provide FAN trainings. We do not profit from these rates. This level is for programs with an annual budget over \$1 million.

**Option B:** 25% price reduction | For programs with an annual budget of \$500k–\$1 million.

**Option C:** 50% price reduction | For programs with an annual budget of less than \$500k.
